

Notes for determining what to swim on the meet sign-up sheet.

The fun meets are just that, Fun meets. These meets introduce the swimmers to how meets are conducted. Everyone who swims gets a ribbon.

The Pentathlon is for experienced swimmers. A swimmer must be able to do all 4 strokes plus the IM. If you enter this meet, you must swim all of the events. This meet is a computer scored meet. There will be officials at this meet. A swimmer can get disqualified (DQ) for an infraction of a stroke. Ribbons will be given for the top swimmers at this meet.

The Invitational is for beginner swimmers or for those who cannot attend the Pentathlon. This is a computerized scored meet. There will be officials at this meet. DQ's (disqualifications) will be given for an infraction of a stroke. There are relays at this meet. Ribbons will be given for the top swimmers at this meet.

The Splash is a different type of meet. It is a computerized scored meet. There are officials at this meet. **BUT**, there are regular events and then there are some shorter events for the older kids. There are mixed relays, duck races, corkscrew races and other fun stuff. This meet will also be held with the older swimmers swimming on one day & the younger swimmers swimming on the other day. Ribbons will be given for the top swimmers at this meet.

The League Championship is the swimming super bowl for the NGSL. This is a computerized scored meet. The team goes for points in order to win a trophy at the end of the meet. Each swimmer who places 8th or higher gets the team points. There is also a chance for each swimmer that earns points to win a "high Point trophy" at the end of the meet. Trophies and ribbons given at this meet.

The District swim meet is for those who want to compete at the state level. Only the top 3 winners of each event will qualify for state. If you swim at his meet you are committing to go to the state swim meet.

The State meet is for the swimmers who qualified at the district meet. This is a computerized scored meet. There are strict officials at this meet. Only the top 8 in each event will be recognized. 1-3 get medals & 4-8 get ribbons. This meet is **highly competitive**.
